We are deeply grateful for your continued support and prayers as we move forward in faith, trusting that God will use Asian Hope to transform even more lives for His glory.



In 2024...

We broke ground and opened on our first-ever **Kingdom School**, bringing quality, tuition-based education and scholarships to even more regions of Cambodia. These schools provide not only access to the Gospel of Jesus Christ but also a safe haven where children can gain the tools they need to build a brighter future.

Through this school model, Asian Hope partners with local churches to identify future educators, inviting them into a Teacher Training Program that creates jobs and strengthens communities. International donors provide the start up costs that open the doors to the school and the model of the tuition based and scholarship schools in the Asian Hope School system sustain the ongoing operations. This new school model accelerates our mission of expanding Christian education to all 25 provinces of Cambodia.

THE ASIAN HOPE SCHOOL SYSTEM

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LOGOS INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL



Logos International School is the founding school of the Asian Hope School System.

Taught in English, Logos educates children from upwardly mobile families from Cambodia and from around the world. This unique positioning allows students to graduate with both an internationally accredited education and a heart for Christ, equipping them to spread the Gospel to all corners of the earth.

VILLAGE DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM SCHOOLS



VDP Schools function across Cambodia as supplemental education centers that ensure local students have access to life changing education and the hope of Christ.

Designed to not only provide fully scholarshiped education, these schools provide basic needs and safety to some of the most vulnerable children in the provinces they exist in.

ASIAN HOPE INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL



Asian Hope International Schools provide a bilingual (English and Khmer) Christian education to national students.

With a focus on preparing students for the national important exams in grades 6, 9, and 12, over 90% of graduates go on to attend domestic or international universities - bringing with them the Biblical foundations the learned at AHIS.

KINGDOM SCHOOLS



Kingdom Schools are a key initiative in achieving Asian Hope's initiative to bring Christian education to every corner of Cambodia via their tuition & scholarshiped hybrid model.

Taught primarily in Khmer by locally trained teachers, these schools prepare students for future roles as community members with a foundation in the hope of the Gospel.

An Educator's Viewpoint

LIFELONG OPPORTUNITES, ETERNAL TRANSFORMATION



Cody Rogers, Director of Kingdom Schools & Director of Operations for International Schools, understands that a classroom is more than just a place for learning—it's a launching pad for lifelong transformation.

With an MBA and over a decade in international education, Cody's career path initially seemed worlds apart from his business background. However, his journey came full circle when he found the perfect intersection of business and education. While visiting Cambodia as tourists, he and his wife were profoundly moved by the country and felt a deep calling to serve there. Inspired by the idea of starting a Christian school, Cody developed a business plan-only to discover that Asian Hope had already established a model he deeply admired. Drawn to their mission, he joined as an English teacher, but over time, his business expertise became instrumental in expanding educational initiatives, including the development of Kingdom Schools.

From the beginning, Cody recognized Asian Hope's unique approach—using education to share the gospel while serving children across diverse socioeconomic backgrounds. He envisions the long-term impact of Christian education stretching far beyond the classroom, shaping future leaders across the globe.

"Teachers spend eight hours a day with students," Cody explains, emphasizing how education shapes a child's worldview—often for life. Many students in international schools make the decision to follow Jesus, and in turn, they become missionaries to their own families both from Cambodia and abroad. Some of these families hold positions of influence in nations that have been historically closed to Christianity. Cody imagines the ripple effect: as these young leaders step into influential roles, their openness to faith could become the catalyst for change in their home countries. Even for those who don't immediately embrace Christianity, their exposure to the Gospel through education can soften their hearts and open doors for faith in the future. The impact of education in Cambodia itself cannot be underestimated. Access to learning transforms entire communities, turning them into centers of knowledge and hope. Even in areas once resistant to Christian influence, people have come to appreciate the tangible good that Asian Hope brings—changing not just individual lives, but entire societies.

KINGDOM SCHOOLS: A FULL COMMUNITY IMPACT

Asian Hope's mission is not just about bringing Christian education to the children of Cambodia—it's about transforming entire communities by sharing the hope of the Gospel. Through schools that uplift neighborhoods, jobs that sustain families, and opportunities for children to learn about Jesus, the impact of Asian Hope extends far beyond the classroom. This is especially true of the life changing Teacher Training Program, a key part of the newly launched Kingdom School Model.

Take the story of Kanha, for example. Kanha serves as a second-grade teacher at Kingdom School, and her journey is a testament to God's faithfulness. When asked what this ministry has meant to her, she shared:

"I am thankful to God that I learned of Kingdom School and that they accepted me to serve as a teacher. I have been a Christian for several years, but my husband did not agree to follow Jesus with me...At the lowest point in my life, Kingdom School became a lifeline to me as a single mom with two children."

Kingdom School provided Kanha with more than just a job—it provided a support system. She expressed deep gratitude for those who stood by her, saying:

"(Asian Hope) agreed to sponsor the cost of childcare, which helped me get through the teacher training. The daily devotions with staff have also strengthened my walk with God. My co-workers have become close friends, and it is like I have new brothers and sisters in my life."

As Kanha faithfully followed God's calling, she witnessed an incredible transformation in her own family. Her husband, once opposed to her faith, began to see the changes in her life.



"My husband called me one day to tell me that he now believes in Jesus too! God answered my prayers! This gave me hope that God could restore our marriage and provide a good home for our two daughters."

Today, Kanha and her husband are reunited, growing in faith together, and striving to raise their children in a Christ-centered home. She continues to teach at Kingdom School, sharing the love of Jesus with her students and their families.



- Expand Asian Hope International School (AHIS) by complete the campus expansion at AHIS. This space allows us to welcome an additional 400 students in 2026. A major step forward in our commitment to excellence and accessibility.
- Grow the Kingdom School in Battambang: After successfully launching our first Kingdom School, we're excited to grow our Kingdom School in Battambang by welcoming more students and deepening our impact in the community. We are also in the early stages of planning for a second future location.
- Improve Facilities Across Village Schools: We will execute a comprehensive facilities improvement plan across our Village Schools to better support our expanding student body and dedicated staff. These improvements ensure the learning environments continue to meet the needs of the children we serve.
